The Town of Davie has hired Whitaker Contracting Corporation and ISG Strategic Partners to treat the streets in Waterford with a pavement preservation product, HA5, which is intended to extend the life of the streets decades past their design life and save residents road re-surfacing costs. **The roads will be treated in Waterford beginning February 26, 2018, weather permitting.**

To obtain the full benefit of the treatment to maximize the financial savings, the Town asks residents to do the following:

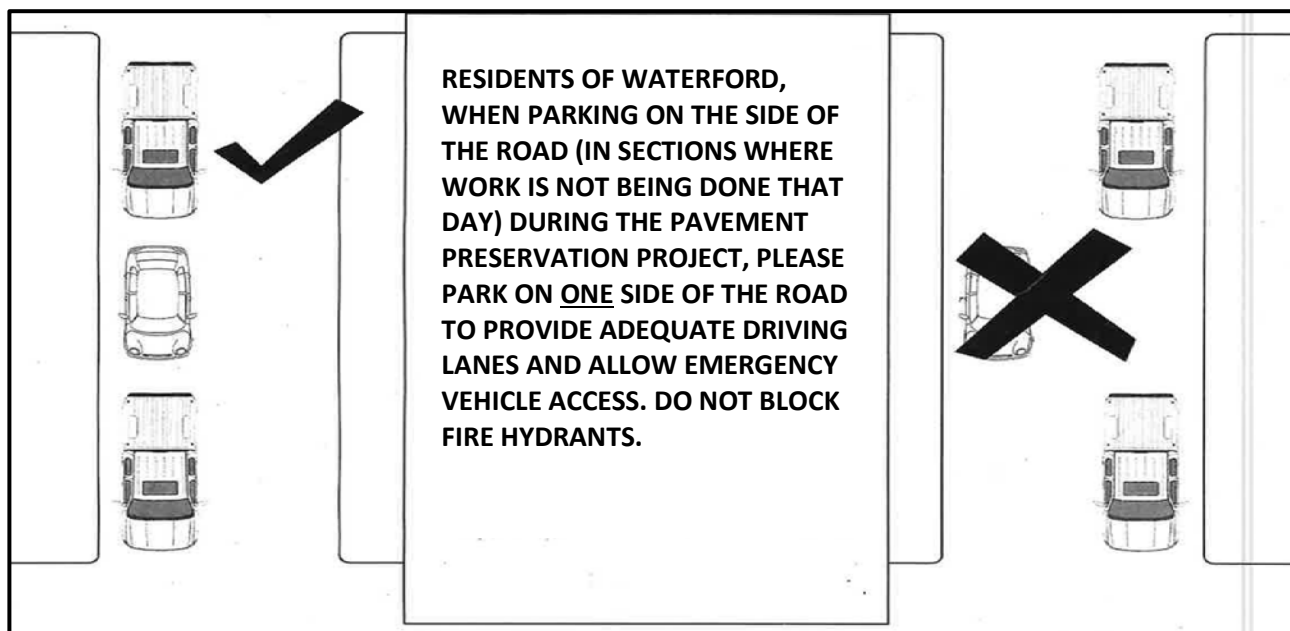
1. Please review the **Work Plan/Map on the back page**; at that time, please note the one day that the work will be done in front of your home. **Work is projected to begin on February 26, weather permitting (see map/schedule on back).**
2. **ALL OUTSIDE WATER/IRRIGATION MUST BE TURNED OFF.** So that the contractor can apply the treatment in a dry condition, please make sure your irrigation system is turned off between 6:00 pm the day before the work is scheduled to be done in front of your home and midnight of the work day.
3. **PARKING INFORMATION:** Between 7:00 am on the work day in front of your home to 6:00 am the following day while the treatment is drying and curing, **DO NOT WALK AND/OR DRIVE ON THE TREATED STREET.** **Please plan for all residents and/or guests of your home to park along one side of the roadways within the community not in the specified work areas for that day. Please only park on one side of the street (SEE IMAGE ON BACK) to allow emergency vehicles access to the neighborhood.** Driving on the road earlier will damage the work, cause the product to get on your tires and potentially spread on to your property. **If your car is parked on the street the day the work is being done on the section of your road, this section may not be treated.**
4. **CAUTION:** Please be careful when driving through the neighborhood during project as some traffic control devices will be covered.
5. **DO NOT WALK ON ROADS** during the drying time. When the roads are opened back to traffic, only then can you walk on the roads.
6. **SERVICE VENDORS:** Please ask any service vendors (i.e., landscapers) to avoid working on the days that the treatment is planned to be done in your community.
7. **GARBAGE & MAIL:** The Contractor is coordinating with Waste Management and the USPS.
8. **SPECIAL NEEDS:** If you have any special needs that need to be accommodated, please contact Stephen White @ 727-333-5897.
9. **Weather may cause a halt to the project so please be aware that dates are subject to change.** We will keep you notified. Look for message boards for updates.

FAQs

- What is HA5? HA5 is a high density mineral bond and is used by cities, counties and state departments of transportation to preserve asphalt and make the roads last longer. It protects the roads from the sun and rain which both cause damage to roadways. It also makes the road look new for a very long time.
- Why do I have to stay off the road for 24 hours? HA5 needs sufficient time to completely cure.
- What happens if there is an emergency? Emergency vehicles will be allowed access to the neighborhood 24/7.
